


<p>Transport</p>	<p>Florida Universit�ria’s main campus is located at Catarroja (7Km on the South of Valencia), but most of the international exchange students choose to live in Valencia and come by public transport.</p> <p>Train: It takes 11 minutes to get from Valencia North (train) Station (Estaci�n del Norte) to Catarroja Train station and then around 15 min walk to Florida. Short distance train schedules: Link</p> <p>Coach Catarroja Station to Florida Universit�ria During the academic year Florida provides a free coach service from /to Catarroja train station before the first lecture in the morning/afternoon and after the last lectures in the morning/evening: Link</p> <p>The city of Valencia is also connected to Catarroja by bus, leaving from the “Plaza de Espa�a” at the centre of Valencia city.</p>
<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>Valencia is one of the main Erasmus destinations in Europe. The demand and price of accommodation has increased a lot in the last years.</p> <p>There are many student’s residences as well as companies offering rooms in shared flats.
